Dear Mr. Farnes,

This letter is in follow up to the March 3, 2022, Radio Advisory Board of Canada (RABC) quarterly meeting where ISED announced that a revised draft of CPC-2-0-20, Issue 2, *Radio Frequency Exposure – Site Compliance and Access Control* had been finalised and would be provided to RABC for comment soon. A draft of this document has been attached to this correspondence for this purpose.

For context, CPC 2-0-03 *Radiocommunication and Broadcasting Antenna Systems* requires that antenna installation operators must meet Health Canada's *Safety Code 6 (SC6)* at all times. CPC-2-0-20 details the manner in which this is to be done.

The included draft provides more detail than the current version on acceptable methods to ensure site compliance. We are providing this document to the RABC to solicit feedback on any items within the document that members feel may require further clarification.

We ask that the RABC submit its comments to us in writing by July 14, 2022. After reviewing the comments, ISED will then proceed with a public consultation on the proposed document in accordance with its usual process for amending CPCs.

We look forward to receiving the RABC's feedback.
