Re: RSS-246, Issue 1, November 2018 - Ultra-Low Power (ULP) Wireless Medical Endoscopy Devices Operating in the 430-440 MHz Band

In November 2018, the Department requested the RABC review the proposed new standard RSS-246. The Board assigned the review to the Chair of the RABC EMC Committee and we informed members of the review. At the request of the Department, we invited representatives from Medtronic to participate in the review as guests. We also notified MEDEC that we would be reviewing RSS-246. It is our understanding that MEDEC notified its members of the review.

At the request of the Department, the consultation was posted to the RABC website in order to facilitate the receipt of comments from WTO members.

We held one call to review the proposed standard. Several representatives from Medtronic participated and they stated that they were satisfied with the proposed RSS-246. RABC members did not express interest in the standard.
