Subject: *SPR-002, Issue 2 – Supplementary Procedure for Assessing Compliance of Equipment Operating from 3 kHz to 10 MHz with RSS-102*

Dear Ms. Gallant,

In December 2021, the Department requested the RABC review the draft issue 2 of SPR-002, Supplementary Procedure for Assessing Compliance of Equipment Operating from 3 kHz to 10 MHz with RSS-102. The Board assigned the review of the Supplementary Procedure to its Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) Committee. At the request of the Department, RABC also posted the consultation on its website to facilitate comments from Canada's World Trade Organization (WTO) partners.

The EMC Committee held two calls to review the Supplementary Procedure. Invitations to participate in the review were extended to ten guests identified by ISED. There was significant discussion and feedback provided during the calls. RABC members have not identified any additional concerns with the proposed Supplementary Procedure.

In addition, RABC received comments from five stakeholders via the WTO portal on its website. These have been forwarded to the Department for consideration.

The Board has now completed its review. RABC recommends the Department take into consideration the feedback provided prior to publishing the new issue of the Supplementary Procedure. We appreciate having had the opportunity to review the updated standard.
