Subject: SRSP-300-Gen, draft issue 2, and SRSP-301.7, draft issue 5

Dear Josette Gallant,

In September 2025, the Department requested that RABC review draft new issues of: SRSP-300-GEN, *General Technical Requirements for Fixed Radio Systems Operating in Frequency Bands above 960 MHz*; and SRSP-301.7, *Technical Requirements for Fixed Radio Systems Operating in the Bands 1700-1710 MHz and 1780-1850 MHz*. The Board assigned the review of the standard to the Fixed Wireless Communications Committee. The Committee held two meetings to review the proposed changes to the standards.

One minor concern was identified with the wording of Section 1 (Scope) of SRSP-300-GEN, in the third bullet. The wording as drafted is a bit restrictive in the use of “television”. The Board proposes the following change to remove the word “television”:

- Unidirectional point-to-point radio systems used for the distribution of ~~television~~ video or audio broadcasting signals (such as studio-to-transmitter links used to relay television or radio program material between a media studio and the site of broadcasting station); and

In addition, at the request of the Department, RABC posted the draft standard on its website to facilitate comments from Canada’s World Trade Organization (WTO) partners. No comments were received on our WTO portal.

The Board has now completed its review. We appreciate having had the opportunity to review the proposed changes to the standards.
