**Subject: SMSE-003-26 - Proposed Revisions to the
Canadian Table of Frequency Allocations 2026 Edition**

The following constitutes the RABC response to the above noted consultation. The Board created a special working group with broad participation from its members to review the proposed revisions.

During our review, members identified some minor formatting typos to the proposed revisions in Tables 14 and 15. These errors have already been communicated to the Department.

We agree with the Department the proposed revisions reflect the outcomes of the 2023 World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC-23) and domestic requirements. As such, the Board recommends the Department proceed with the revisions to the CTFA.

The response to SMSE-003-26 was sent to RABC Sponsor Members for ballot. Of the Board's 20 Sponsor Members, 12 approved the submission (Canadian Association of Broadcasters, Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police, Canadian Association of Wireless Internet Service Providers, CBC/Radio Canada, Canadian Electronics and Communications Association, Canadian Wireless Alliance, Department of National Defence, NAV CANADA, Radio Amateurs of Canada, Railway Association of Canada, Rogers Communications and TELUS); and 2 abstained (Canadian Association of Broadcast Consultants and Electricity Canada).

We appreciate having had the opportunity to provide comments to this important consultation.
