Re: RSS-125, Issue 3, January 2020 – Land Mobile and Fixed Equipment Operating in the Frequency Range 1.705 to 30 MHz

In January 2020, the Department requested the RABC to review the proposed modifications to RSS-125. The Department requested the RABC to post the consultation to the RABC website in order to facilitate the receipt of comments from WTO members.

The Board assigned the review of RSS-125 to the RABC Mobile and Personal Communications Committee. The committee held one call to review the proposed changes to RSS-125. There were roughly fifteen stakeholders represented on the RABC call. Having considered the comments and discussion of the standard during the RABC call, the Department issued a revised draft of RSS-125.
