Subject: RSS-248, Issue 1, June 2021 – *Radio Local Area Network (RLAN) Devices in the 5925-7125 MHz band*

Dear Ms. Gallant,

In June 2021, the Department requested the RABC review the new Radio Standards Specification RSS-248, Issue 1, June 2021 – *Radio Local Area Network (RLAN) Devices in the 5925-7125 MHz band*. The Board assigned the review of the guidelines to its Fixed Wireless Communications Committee (FWCC). At the request of the Department, RABC also posted the consultation on its website to facilitate comments from Canada's World Trade Organization (WTO) partners.

The FWCC held one meeting, with approximately 30 participants (including invited guests), to review the document. During the meeting, RABC members recommended several changes to the draft standard. Many of the recommendations were editorial in nature. Consequently, the Department shared an updated draft that reflected most of the recommendations. The FWCC is satisfied with the new standard and recommends the Department publish the revised document.

RABC also received 6 comments via the WTO portal on its website and forwarded these comments to the Department for consideration.

The Board has now completed its review. We appreciate having had the opportunity to review the updated guidelines.
