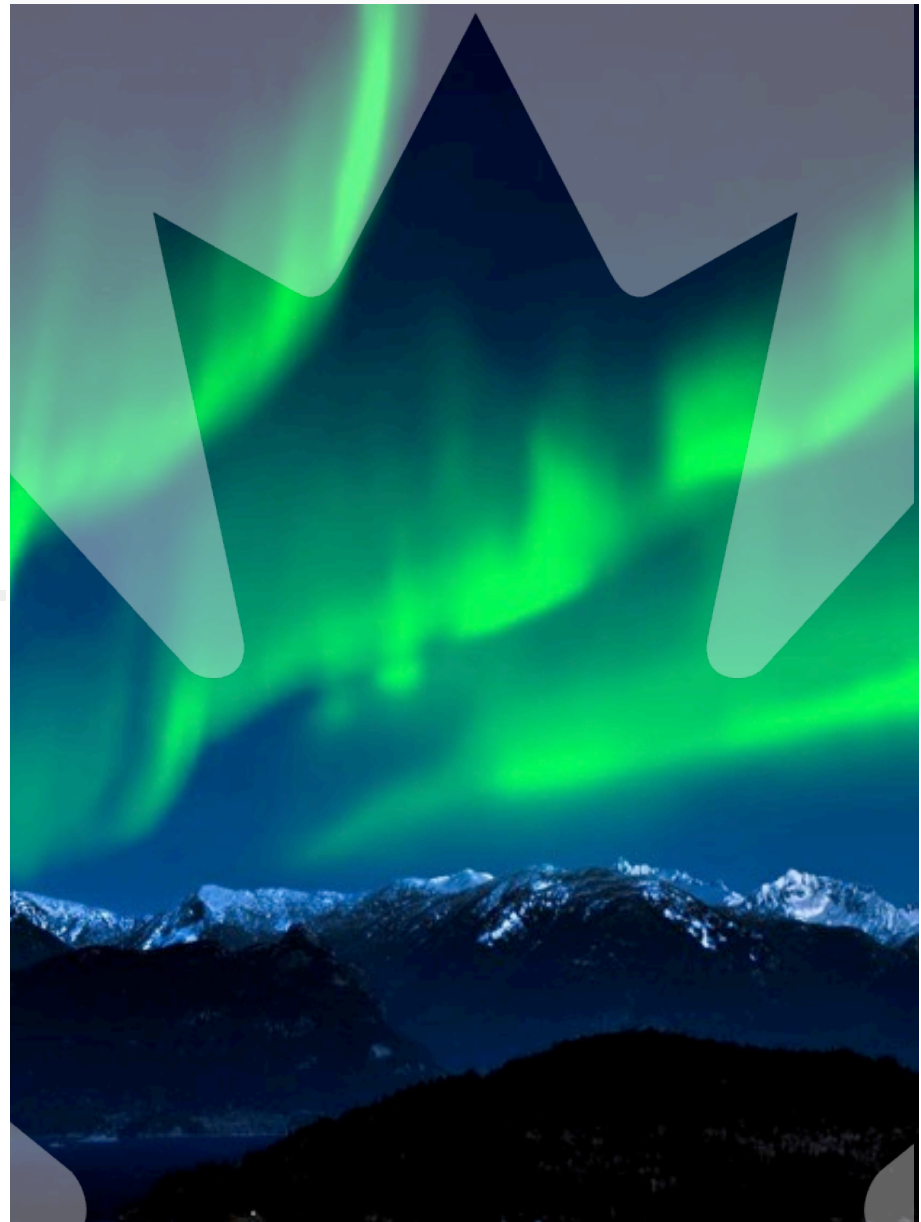

RABC – May 11th, 2017



Publications

- **5150 – 5250 MHz**
 - Consultation comment period closed March 29, 2017
 - The Department received comments from 30 organizations
 - Reply comments were due April 17, 2017
 - Decision expected early summer 2017
- **Dedicated Short-Range Communications (DSRC)**
 - Planned consultation to address vehicle-to-infrastructure in 2017
- **GL-09***
 - New guideline on changes to the processing of land mobile applications
 - Touches on external filtering and same-site interference
 - Publication expected in summer 2017

International Update

No new developments since last update

- **WP 5A (Land mobile service - excluding IMT; wireless access in the fixed service; amateur and amateur-satellite services)**
 - Next meeting is May 22-June 1, 2017
 - Priorities include studies for the 5 GHz band, particularly to initiate work to identify technical and operating requirements for RLANs
 - Continuing progression of work on Reports on PPDR, ITS and Railway Communications
- **WP 5D (IMT Systems)**
 - Next meeting is June 13-21, 2017
 - Priorities include:
 - Issue 9.1.1, dealing with studies involving satellite networks and deciding on an appropriate terrestrial IMT protection criteria for sharing studies
 - Continuing work on Issue 9.1.8, which deals with a frequency arrangement for Machine Type Communications (MTC).
 - Updating Recommendation ITU-R M.1036 on frequency arrangements for IMT
 - To not limit IMT deployment to bands identified as IMT,
 - ensure that all bands with an identification are treated equally in document, and;
 - ensure that 3400-3700 MHz TDD frequency arrangement is included.

International Update (cont.)

- **TG 5/1**
 - Next Meeting is May 15-23, 2017
 - Input from contributing working parties was due March 31, 2017
 - Information from satellite groups missing the protection criteria and debate ongoing
 - Priorities for Canada:
 - Finalize prioritization of bands for study
 - Assist TG in agreeing on methodology for studies and agreements on parameters
 - Contribute strategically to studies where Canada has unique interests or where less input is expected from other administrations
