Dear Mr. Poirier:

Thank you for your letter, dated September 16, 2013, in which you express the RABC's concerns relating to the signage requirements for Uncontrolled Environments as they relate to Health Canada's Safety Code 6.

The signage recommendations found in Industry Canada's procedure (CPC-2-0-20<sup>1</sup>) were amended to align with Health Canada's document entitled "*Technical Guide for Interpretation and Compliance Assessment of Health Canada's Radiofrequency Exposure Guidelines*". The minimum requirements for posting demarcation signs are listed in Section 3 of the procedure however, operators/site owners are encouraged to exceed the minimum requirements depending on local circumstances.

Please note that Industry Canada is not requesting operators/site owners to change their existing signage but only to consider transitioning gradually to the recommended signage; noting the objective is to ensure the protection of the general public.

Thank you once again for sharing your concerns and comments.
